Who should attend?

Business and regulatory managers and specialists working in companies that make, import or use chemicals (essentially every manufacturing or construction business within or supplying to the EU) who are beginning to define their obligations under REACH and the CLP regulation.

The REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and restriction of CHEMicals) Regulation is fundamentally changing the shape of every supply chain within the EU. REACH affects all chemical substances that you **manufacture, import or use** to make your products and to run your processes.

If you need to know more about REACH then the chances are that you will also be affected by the new EU Regulation on Classification, Labelling and Packaging of substances and mixtures (CLP). So in the afternoon we will provide attendees with an overview of what this could mean for your business.

And as if that's not enough, EU Safety Data Sheets are changing too. We will close the day with an outline of the changes to this aspect of communicating hazard and risk management information within the supply chain.
